Departmental Examination on Law and Statutory Rules

- 1. The Departmental examination on Law and Statutory Rules shall comprise one paper carrying one hundred marks.
 - 2. The syllabus shall, consists of the following subjects, namely:-
 - (i) the Registration Act, 1908 (as amended upto-date), the rules framed thereunder, the table of fees prescribed thereunder and all the Acts and rules having a bearing on the Registration Act, 1908 and
 - (ii) the Indian Stamp Act (as amended up to date), the rules framed thereunder and the orders issued thereunder.
 - 3. The examination shall be of three hours duration.
- 4. The examinees shall be allowed to avail of the assistance of unannotated editions of the Acts, Rules and orders.
- 5. Examinees who obtain not less than fifty per cent of the marks shall be deemed to have passed."
